PLAYERS WELFARE

Parents who attend games play an important role in providing a safe and enjoyable experience for Players, other Spectators and Officials.

Playball encourages the desire of players & spectators to win games but encourage much more the gaining of individual & team <u>skills</u> and playing the game with respect to opponents and officials.

Any disrespect of Playball officials will be delt with quickly and severely. Playball has a **ZERO** tolerance of abuse. Penalties apply as per Playball <u>By-Laws</u> which all parents agree to when registering their player for the season via Play-HQ.

WHEN AT STADIUMS

- Please respect all school property and always supervise children.
- Dispose of any **rubbish** generated in bins or take with you and **depart quietly** for neighbourhood amenity.
- There is to be **no food** consumed in any stadiums please.
- For **First Aid** at MSAC, please see the Playball First Aid Officer in the First Aid Room opposite Court.7. At all other Courts: Referees carry a First-Aid Kit in their equipment bag, if required.

RULE REMINDERS

- Rules Summary <u>here</u>. Complete Rules <u>here</u>. No-Zone rule <u>here</u> applies in all Playball competitions. (play <u>help-side--defence</u> or <u>man-to-man</u>)
- 2. **Teams leading by 10 points** (15-points for Years 5 & 6 & MSAC Wednesday Year 4's) must fall back within the 3-point arc until the ball passes half court; then players may leave the 3-point arc to play defence.
- 3. Maximum Individual Points: <u>Ten points</u> maximum per player per half Years 1-4. (<u>Twelve points</u> max per half for Years 5&6 and MSAC Wednesday Year 4's). <u>Excess points are deducted</u> from the score sheet at the game's conclusion.
- 4. **Match Clock** does not stop. (Final Night clock stops in the last 1-minute for Grand Finals and for all whistles in the last 1-minute where points difference is 6-points or under)
- 5. **Scoresheet.** Score persons, please complete the score sheet with player **First name and Surname** prior to scheduled game time. Game clock starts on time. Play will commence once score sheet is complete.
